Subject: Internal Assessment, B. Pharmacy I Semester (Regular) Non-University Examination, Communication Skills, Remedial Mathematics/ Biology Theory & Practical and B. Pharmacy VII Semester Practice School.

All the Pharmacy College Principals are hereby informed that the following details are to be noted for the submission of **B. Pharmacy I Semester (Regular) CBSS Non-University Examinations: Communication Skills, Remedial Mathematics/ Biology Theory & Practical and B. Pharmacy VII Semester Practice School** for the academic year 2023-24.

1. B. Pharmacy I Semester (Regular) Non-University Examinations: Communication Skills, Remedial Mathematics/ Biology Theory & Practical Examinations will have to be conducted on or before **29-02-2024** in offline mode.
2. Principals are advised to collect three copies of project work report from each student, which should be produced at the time of Viva-Voce for the use of Examiner(s) deputed for conducting the Viva Voce Examination on the specified date(s). The Principals are requested to forward one copy of the project report of each student who has registered for **VII-Semester Examination** duly certified by the Supervisor and Principal of the college along with **TWO** copies of Nominal Rolls of each student. Those candidates who do not applied for the **VII-Semester Examination** will not be considered for taking the Examination.
3. External Practical Examinations for **B. Pharmacy I, III, V & VII Semester (Regular)** have to be conducted from **29-02-2024 to 07-03-2024**.
4. **Last Date for the Submission of Internal Assessment** Marks of students appearing **B. Pharmacy I, III, V & VII Semester (Regular)** Examinations Feb-2024, pertaining to **External Non-University Exams** along with manual D-Form to the Examination Branch is on or before **04-03-2024**. If not submitted, fine will be imposed after the due date.
5. Maximum internal assessment marks for all students of **B. Pharmacy I, III, V & VII Semester (Regular)** courses is **25**.
6. Absent should be noted as **“AB”**. Principals will be held responsible for entries made in the Award List for all the examinations held at colleges.
7. Marks submitted by the college are final and there is no provision for alteration.
