The Principals are requested to transfer consolidated Exam fee amount into Registrar, Palamuru University Examination Fee Fund A/c No: 62078258948 (SBI, Ganesh Nagar Branch, Mahabubnagar, IFSC Code "SBIN0016375") in any branch of State Bank of India only through NEFT/RTGS and obtain a receipt from the bank and submit the same to the Examination Branch, PU along with application forms.

NOTE:

- 1. Cash Deposits/Challans are not accepted. Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 2. The students are advised to enclose Xerox copies of their qualifying examination (Previous Examination Memos) attested by the college Principal concerned with the examination application form. The submission of application(s) after the last date will attract penalty of **Rs. 1000/- per day**. Xerox copies of Examination application forms &photographs will not be considered.

- **3.** Application forms of Pharm-D (6YDC) VI year and Pharm-D (3YDC) III year should be accompanied with all the memos of previous semesters (i.e. I-V years for 6YDC and I-II years for 3YDC.)
- 4. Final year students who have registered for Pharm-D (6YDC) VI Year (Regular) and Pharm-D (3YDC) III Year (Regular) examination should submit TWO certified copies of Project report and Hospital report (Report consisting specific objectives of the work, methodology, results, discussions and conclusions signed by Preceptor, Head of the Department or Head of the Institution concerned) of their internship to the concerned college Principal.
- 5. The Principal should forward ONE Copy of the Project report of each student along with Hospital report and Nominal Roll's on or before 22-06-2023. The Second copy of the project report has to be kept with the college and the same has to be provided to the Examiner(s) deputed by the University for conducting the Viva-Voce Examination on the specified date(s). Those candidates who do not register for the assessment will not be considered for taking the assessment. The Principals are requested to contact the Controller of Examination for their final Viva-Voce dates.
- 6. "NO DUES CERTIFICATE" from the Director, Academic Audit Cell, PU, shall be enclosed with the forwarding letter.
- 7. Not to collect the Exam fee (In case of VI- Year (6YDC) & III Year (3YDC) collect memo's fee and Consolidated Fee Rs.500/-+ Provisional Fee Rs.100/-only) from the Visually Challenged, Physically Challenged, Hearing Impaired & Orally Challenged students. A Xerox Copy of Medical Certificate confirming their status as Physically Challenged (Minimum percentage of disability must be of 40%) must be attached to the Application forms. These Students' Application forms should be submitted separately along with Separate Nominal Roll.
- 8. The Candidate's/Father's /Mother's name(s) should be submitted to the examination branch as per the qualifying examination(s)/Intermediate Certificate. Any deviation will attract a penalty of Rs.100/- per name correction by the examination branch.
- 9. Principals are hereby requested not to forward Supplementary candidate's applications.
- 10. Last date for submission of application forms, nominal rolls and the details of fee paid to the Controller of Examinations, PU is 22-06-2023.
